TRUSTEE REPORTS

British Columbia School Trustees' Association/British Columbia Public School Employers' Association New Trustee Academy of February 9th – 10th, 2012

Trustees Dubasov and Rorstad attended the academy as new trustees. Trustee Rorstad provided each trustee with copies of handouts provided at the academy containing good information for trustees. Trustee Dubasov reported that he enjoyed Minister of Education Abbott's workshop presentation on "How to get along with everyone" and that all of the workshops he attended were very good. Trustee Chell confirmed that he also attended the academy and noted that holding a joint academy worked very well. It was a good opportunity to talk about the roles of the British Columbia Public School Employers Association.

Early Childhood Development Committee Meeting of February 20th, 2012

Superintendent Cooper reviewed the Minutes highlighting the positive feedback received from Mary McNeil, Minister of Children and Family Development and Norm MacDonald, MLA with respect to the signing of the Revelstoke Children's Charter. Superintendent Cooper advised that the Committee's goal setting meeting has been set for March 5th, 2012 and will be facilitated by Trustee Chell.

British Columbia School Trustees' Association Provincial Council Meeting of February 24th – 26th, 2012

Trustee Nicholson attended the meeting and reported that Deputy Minister Gorman addressed the meeting and gave a rationale for the provincial budget. Trustee Nicholson confirmed that the freeze on provincial government assets has been lifted which may allow for the disposal of some surplus assets. He noted that the directors were entitled to a pay increase but declined the increase due to the net zero mandate the government has set for provincial government employees. A "super" conference is being planned for November 15 and 16 of 2012, which will be for all education stakeholders. Due to the November conference, there will not be a December trustee academy.

Trustee Chell explained the different roles of mediators and arbitrators. Trustees expressed that they would like to see an end to the current strike action and made the following motion.
