SUPERINTENDENT HOOKER (CONTINUED)

Middle Years Development Instrument Results for Grades 4 and 7 in 2014/15

Superintendent Hooker reviewed the Middle Years Development Instrument (MDI) results for 2014/15 highlighting the data generated by the MDI, how students are involved conversations about the results, and how the results are used at the district and school levels to focus resources, programs and services on identified areas of need. He noed that the MDI is a tool and should not be used as a measure of success.

Policy 2.1 Procedural Bylaw

Superintendent Hooker explained that the Policy Review Committee revised the policy by making revisions to the "Delegations" section of the policy to clarify that the Board may not make a decision on requests by a delegation at the meeting at which the delegation is heard. The policy was also revised to add an acknowledgement of traditional Aboriginal territories. The policy was circulated for feedback. No feedback was received and no further changes to the policy have been made.
