SUPERINTENDENT HOOKER

Highlighted Activities: Superintendent Hooker

Received as information.

Superintendent Hooker presented his highlighted activities, noting the Regional Professional Development event held in Kelowna and he thanked Tamm Tomm and Tracey Hill for their presentation of "Exploration Fridays". He also thanked Arrow Heights Elementary School staff for their patience with the delays in the completion of the upgrading of the HVAC system adding that Secretary Treasurer Tisdale and Operations Manager Shingler continue to do "daily check-in" on the project. Superintendent Hooker confirmed that the 2017/2018 draft calendar has been circulated to CUPE, the Revelstoke Teachers' Association, the District Parent Advisory Council and the Parent Advisory Councils of each school for feedback. The final calendar will be brought to the Board at the March 1st, 2017 school board meeting. He added that he together with RTA President Rogers are meeting with the staff of each school to determine how the recently announced additional funding will be allocated to schools.
