Administration Report: Superintendent Hooker

Superintendent Hooker presented his Administration Reporting highlighting the Board's work on reviewing and revising the district's Mission Vision Values and Goals. Once a draft has been finalized, the document will be shared with Principals, Parent Advisory Councils, the District

Parent Advisory Council, the Revelstoke Teachers' Association, and CUPE. He also highlighted the meeting between the Arrow Heights Elementary School Parent Advisory Council and City of Revelstoke Staff regarding traffic safety at the school. He noted the many parents and community members who volunteer in our schools explaining that there is Board policy which governs volunteers and Administrative Protocols with respect to the volunteer screening process.
